No, we welcome olive donations from everyone, such as your own backyard pick, provided:

- The olives are picked between Friday 22nd – Sunday 24th April.
- The olives aren't wet or squishy / rotten– these are not good for oil!
- Using olives with a high oil context, rather than those best for marinating (ask us if unsure)
